In November 2022, Bro. Nathaniel Schreckhise was installed as pastor over the headquarters church in La Ceiba, while his father continues to travel the country working and ministering with other churches.

The La Ceiba church recently purchased a new property and has plans to build a large sanctuary. They are currently having services in a remodeled portion of an existing building on that property. Bro. Schreckhise envisions planting more churches throughout La Ceiba.

La Ceiba is located on the northern coast of Honduras. Approximately 230,000 people find their home in this coastal city overlooking the Caribbean Sea. Both Catholicism and other denominational churches are prevalent throughout the city, engulfing people in false doctrine. Witchcraft, and the superstition that comes along with it, is prevalent throughout the Honduran culture.

The combination of a corrupt government, drug addiction, and gang violence leaves people trapped in their suffering. Immorality runs rampant, leaving many broken homes and unstable families. Communism is at the brink of taking over the currently democratic government. This has thrown the people into even deeper despair and the need for the Comforter is greater than ever before.
